What's deliberately not here

- **Paywalled PDFs.** NEJM, JAMA, Elsevier, and Wiley articles are linked via DOI/PubMed URL; PDFs were not downloaded because the network allowlist blocks those domains and because re-hosting is not appropriate. A reviewer with institutional library access can pull full text via the DOI.
- **Cached forum threads or community-testing summaries.** These were not used as primary sources. Where community testing is mentioned in the tool (e.g., Janoshik testing of GLP-1 vials), the prose attributes it as community data, not peer-reviewed evidence.
